“The spectacular 2002 Cabernet Sauvignon was performing even better out of bottle than it did from cask, not an unusual occurrence at this winery. All of these wines are bottled unfined and unfiltered after spending 30+ months in cask. The 2002 is a great example of this fabulously concentrated, rich, California-styled vintage. An opaque purple color is accompanied by aromas of creme de cassis liqueur intermixed with smoky oak, blackberries, flowers, and cedar. Massive richness, full body, and good balance along with ripe tannin, fresh acidity, and a persistent finish characterize this 20-25-year wine.”
