“A wine that I love, and a super bargain, is their 2007 Scout’s Honor. A blend of Zinfandel and Petite Sirah, with a small amount of charbono thrown in, this is one heck of a seductive wine that continues to be the kind of wine you wish more California wineries would make. This might be the best Scout’s Honor cuvee that Kirk Venge has yet produced. Deep bluish/plum/purple, with an explosively aromatic nose of sweet roasted herbs and black and red cherries intermixed with blackberry, licorice, pepper, and floral notes, this wine has loads of fruit, an opulent, voluptuous mouth feel, superb purity and texture, and a full-bodied finish. It is irresistible already, and promises to drink well for at least 6-7 years, assuming you can resist it.”
