“Brooding, dense, concentrated, bordering on excessively ripe and so very deep and compelling for those who like mass and might in their Syrahs, this one might pass for Petite Sirah if it came with the tannins to match the rest of its construction. But, breed and depth win out in the end, and there is a more open aspect to the wine that will stand it in good stead with Moussaka or suet braised bavet of beef.”
